## About NISTD

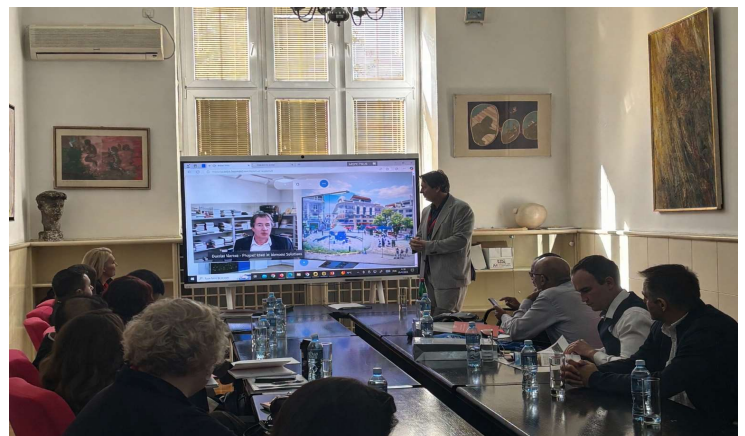
